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POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR WOUND CARE

AFTER SURGERY:

- 1) Clean wound with a mixture of half water and half hydrogen peroxide three times a day.
- 2) Apply antibiotic ointment (NOT Neosporin) to the wound three times a day.
- 3) Cover with a sterile dressing, if instructed.

AFTER SUTURES ARE REMOVED AND SUTURE "HOLES" ARE HEALED;

OR

6 WEEKS FROM DATE OF SURGERY:

1) Apply any type of lotion (i.e. Vaseline Intensive Care, Vitamin E) to suture site,

<u>AND</u>

2) Massage 1 to 2 times daily in a circular motion for 5 minutes, for 2 months. This will help the scar to heal better.
